- What can be done

PREPARATION OF WARNING

- A good PWS involves the production & early warning of the impending disaster.
- Severe weather in Zambia mainly occurs as floods and flash floods, Frost and drought
- Preparation of the warning is done by ZMD in the form of press releases and sent to all stakeholders
- In case of extreme weather events ZMD does not issue warnings but issue advisories to disaster management and mitigation Unit (DMMU)



- Issuing of flood warnings is the mandate of the (DMMU),
- It is only effected after DMMU has gotten inputs & approval from all stake holders involved in flood forecasting before a warning can be issued

CHALLENGES WORKING WITH DMMU

- Sometimes DMMU disseminate the impending weather phenomena and distort the information
- Concentrate more on response measures instead of early warning
- Sometimes they delay in responding to a warning



FEEDBACK FROM DMMU

- When they use the information in their contingency planning
- By them involving Met staff at all levels their planning purposes

CHALLENGES WORKING WITH MEDIA

• There is no good working relationship

- They like changing the information and misquoting
- Some of the Radio stations and some private print media get weather forecast from internet
- They are more active after an event
- At times they tend to omit important information when reporting

WHAT CAN BE DONE AND HOW

- NMS pws to build good working relations with the media by involving in all the Met activities like production
- Create news point
- Media breakfast must be encouraged prior to any important occurrence e.g WMO day, press releases or briefing and warning, seasonal forecast launch
